1. What did you like best about *Finding Heaven*? What did you like least?
2. Share a favourite quote or passage from the book. Why did this quote stand out to you?
3. What made the settings important to the story? Could this story have taken place anywhere else?
4. What themes did you see throughout *Finding Heaven*?
5. How did the characters change throughout the story? How did your opinion of them change?
6. Some scenes in *Finding Heaven* tend to evoke strong emotional reactions. If this was the case for you and you're comfortable sharing, which scenes were the most evocative, and what feelings did they evoke for you? Why?
7. What did you think of the title *Finding Heaven* in relation to the book's contents? What other title might be a good choice for the book?
8. Did any of the characters in *Finding Heaven* remind you of anyone? Did you relate to any of them? If so, what was it about them that you connected with?
9. Did you learn anything new about the subjects of domestic violence or human trafficking from reading *Finding Heaven*? Did it leave you with any unresolved questions?
10. Did the book change your opinion about anything? Do you feel different now than before you read it?
